More tech: Heads-up display (HUD) in Haval Jolion Pro Ultra Hybrid model only.

So you can keep your eyes on the road, there's a handy HUD reflected on your front windscreen.

Use it to quickly check key vehicle details. If you want to change the angle view, brightness or the information shown, click the 'vehicle icon' from the infotainment screen then search 'HUD settings'.

More features: Infotainment

You can change most settings through your infotainment screen – at the centre of your dashboard.

When you start the car, you'll see the home screen with icons below to guide you through everything from media to general settings. Just click the 'home icon' in the top corner, any time, to go back.

Want to make quick changes?

Use the shortcut buttons underneath the infotainment screen for climate control, camera, Auto Park Assist and a mute audio button.

Driver data

To see driver data, press and hold the 'OK' button on the steering wheel until the menu appears. Toggle through the options using the up or down 'Page-turn' buttons.

You can also repeatedly press the 'Back' button on the steering wheel to toggle through options such as data, warnings and mobile phone call information.

More atmosphere: Interior Ambient Lighting

Set the right mood by adjusting the brightness and colour of your interior lights.

Tap the vehicle icon from the infotainment home screen and search 'Light Setting'. This will open a list with 'Atmosphere Lamp Setting' at the bottom, where you can make your changes.

More entertainment: DAB

For radio lovers, swipe from the bottom to the top of the infotainment home screen to view all your vehicle applications. Your last app will be 'DAB-Z'. Just tap the icon and press play. You can then select and change your desired station on the infotainment touchscreen.

To store your favourites, press and hold the icon of your chosen station and a star will appear in the top right corner. To view your favourites, tap the favourites 'Star' button or tap again to view all.

More comfort: Climate Control

You can heat or cool your car in two different ways:

1. Use the 'on/off' shortcut buttons underneath the infotainment screen.
2. Tap the climate control summary bar (top left corner of infotainment screen, next to 'home icon').

More support: Advanced Driver Assistance Systems (ADAS)

Your new car is kitted out with driver assistance tech to keep you safe and moving.

To make changes, find the 'vehicle icon' from the infotainment home screen. That will open a list of settings, including 'intelligent driving' where you can access all ADAS functions.

Auto-Park Assist (Ultra models only)

Parking is never a drama in the Haval Jolion Pro. Find the 'Park Assist Menu' by clicking the second from the right shortcut button underneath the infotainment screen (with a P and 'steering wheel icon' on it).

Adaptive Cruise Control

To Activate, press the start/stop button  until the intelligent cruise control symbol  shows on the instrument cluster then press **SET**.

To Adjust the cruising speed, press and hold the **RES** or **SET** button until desired speed is shown – then release the button.

To Adjust the distance, press the distance level adjustment button to select the required distance to the vehicle in front and release the button.

To Suspend, press the brake pedal or the set speed release button  on the steering wheel - the intelligent cruise control symbol will turn white.

To Reactivate, press **RES**.

To Turn off, press the start/stop button  to select OFF.
